- The quality of research projects conducted at BPATC has to be ensured.
- Recruiting two doctors at Medical Centre on daily basis and also to procure all necessary equipment to make the dental unit functional.

FTC will also be encouraged to contribute their DA.

The BPATC School & College authority will also make a charity.

BPATC Officers' Club will also make contribution to the charity.
