141st Advanced Course on Administration and Development (ACAD) was held at Bangladesh Public Administration Training Centre (BPATC) from 14th May, 2023 to 12nd July, 2023 and 142nd ACAD started on 23rd July 2023 and finished on 20th September, 2023. The total number of participants for 141st and 142nd was 33 respectively and they were of the rank of Deputy Secretary. The officers equivalent to the rank of Deputy Secretary from the armed forces division also took part the training course.

Shaheed Captain Sheikh Kamal was the younger brother of Sheikh Hasina the current Prime Minister of Bangladesh. He was an organizer of the Mukti Bahini Guerrilla Struggle in 1971. Sheikh Kamal was born at Tungipara village under the Gopalganj subdivision on August 5, 1949. He embraced martyrdom on August 15, 1975 at the age of 26, along with Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and most of their other family members.

The 93rd birth anniversary of Bangamatha Begum Fazilatunnesa Mujib, wife of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman was observed at BPATC auditorium with rich tribute and official decorum. Bangamata, also known by her nickname Renu, was born on 8 August in 1930 to the Muslim Sheikh family in Tungipara village of Gopalganj. Bangamata Begum Fazilatunnesa Mujib was a silent organizer of the liberation struggle of the Bengalis and brought Bangabandhu to the Himalayan height.
