



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between Nepal Administrative Staff College, Nepal (NASC) and

Bangladesh Public Administration Training Centre (BPATC)

Nepal Administrative Staff College, Nepal (NASC) and the Bangladesh Public Administration Training Centre (BPATC), Savar, Dhaka 1343, Bangladesh intend to establish relationin between two institutions in providing, exchange of faculty members and trainees, do hereby agree to develop mutual collaboration and cooperation to achieve the shared goals.

The interested areas of collaboration and cooperation delineated below will be done with mutually agreed terms and conditions based on both parties written consent, fund availability and approval of both institutions. The areas of interest of both parties might be as follows:

- 1. Exchange of faculty members and students.
- Organize customized training courses for Civil Servants / Public Service Managers of Nepal at BPATC.
- 3. Arrange study visit programme for mid and senior level executives of Nepal and NASC at BPATC.
- 4. Arrange participation of Civil Servants / Public Service Managers of Nepal in Advanced Course on Administration and Development, Senior Staff Couse at BPATC.
- 5. Jointly organize international conference/symposium, seminar and workshop on areas/issues of mutual interest.
- 6. Conduct joint research and extend support in knowledge management.

The detailed areas of collaboration, cooperation and funding arrangements under this Memorandum of Understanding will be negotiated under separate agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding comes into force from the date of signing of both parties. The MOU will be valid for 5 years from the date of signing of both parties. Both parties can terminate the MOU with 6 months prior notice.
